Sept. 22	45	45 day notice for federal write-in absentee voters (FWAB), UOCAVA ballots ready
October 9	30	Voter registration deadline at 9:00 p.m., office hours 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.
October 10	29	In person early voting begins at 8:00 a.m., Non-UOCAVA ballots ready
October 15	12	Pre-election campaign finance report filing deadline by 4:00 p.m.
October 25		Pre-election campaign finance report filing deadline by 4:00 p. m.
October 26	11	Filing deadline by 4:00 p.m. for observer appointments
Nov. 3	3	Deadline at 12:00 p.m. to accept applications for absentee ballots to be mailed
Nov. 5	1	Filing deadline by 4:00 p.m. for amendments to observer appointments
Nov. 6		Election Day (Voting Locations voting hours 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.)
Nov. 16	10 after	Ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than November 5 and received by this date to be counted in the official canvass
Nov. 17	11 after	Board of Election offices may begin the official canvass
Nov. 19		Official canvass of November 6 election begins at 1:30 p.m.
Nov. 20		Official certification of November 6 election begins at 3:30 p.m.
Nov. 21	15 after	Board of Election offices must begin the official canvass
Nov. 27	21 after	Board of Election offices must complete official canvass
Dec. 14		Post-election campaign finance report filing deadline by 4:00 p.m.
